## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorney of Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 3rd paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 397 of the public laws of 1965, which relates to the salaries of county attorney and assistant county attorney of Aroostook County, is further amended to read as follows:

county attorney, \$6,500 \$7,000; assistant county attorney, \$4,500 \$5,000;

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and the sum of \$1,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969 to provide for the increase in salaries of the county attorney and assistant county attorney of Aroostook County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
