COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 351, L.D. 433, Bill, "An Act
to Authorize the Construction of a Bridge Across the
Androscoggin River Between the Cities of Auburn and
Lewiston."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by inserting after the words
"coupon bonds" in the 3rd line (same in L.D. 433) the words
'redeemable before maturity'; and by inserting at the end of
said section 2 the following sentence: 'Said bonds when paid
at maturity or otherwise retired shall not be reissued, but may
be refunded on terms more favorable to the State than those in
the original issue.'

Further amend said Bill in section 6 by striking out the
words "at maturity" in the 3rd line (2nd and 3rd lines in L.D. 433)
