STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Reimbursement of Board for Secondary School Pupils.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1292, amended. The last paragraph of section 1292 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

When any administrative unit shall have been required to pay and has paid board for a youth or youths attending secondary school in accordance with section 1291, the superintendent of schools of such administrative unit shall make a return under oath to the commissioner on a form provided for the purpose before the first day of September, annually, for the preceding school year, stating the name and exact residence of each youth for whom board has been paid, the amount paid by the administrative unit for each and the name and location of the school which each has attended. Upon the approval of said return, the commissioner shall apportion to such administrative unit a sum equal to ½ the amount thus paid by such administrative unit.
