AN ACT Relating to Sick Leave for Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1951, amended. Section 1951 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

§ 1951. Minimum sick leave

Each administrative unit operating public schools within the State shall grant all certified teachers, except substitute teachers as defined by the commissioner, a minimum annual sick leave of 10 school days accumulative to a minimum of ~~30~~ 90 school days without loss of salary. Any other plan of sick leave which, in the opinion of the state board, provides at least equal benefits may be approved in lieu thereof.
