AN ACT to Set a Minimum Wage for Substitute Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1901, amended. Section 1901 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding the following paragraph after the first paragraph and table:

The minimum salary for substitute teachers with at least 4 years of education beyond high school and a bachelor's degree or better, who are certified to teach in Maine by the State Department of Education, shall be \$20 a day.
