IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Providing Subsidy to Driver Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 2452, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 2452 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 4 of chapter 51 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:
- 2. Special subsidies. Special subsidy shall be paid in September to the administrative units that have conducted driver education courses meeting standards established by the state board according to the following plan: \$100 for each pupil satisfactorily completing the driver education course during the preceding year.

Notwithstanding sections 1289 and 1291, when a student who has school privileges in an administrative unit not maintaining an approved secondary school, satisfactorily completes an approved driver education course in an approved academy, special subsidy of \$10 \$30 will be paid in September to the administrative unit, which shall pay such special subsidy to the trustees or officers in charge of the said academy.
