SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 310, L. D. 444, Bill, "An Act Relating to Reimbursement for Driver Education and Special Education."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out all of the underlined sentence (same in L.D. 444) and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentences: 'The previous 2 years' resident average daily membership of the pupils enrolled in special education programs as defined in section 3117 shall be used in computing aid for the succeeding biennium. The membership thus determined shall be multiplied by 2 before applying the appropriate adjustment factors and the per pupil allowance in computing the foundation program. A unit shall receive a minimum of \$300 per pupil for each student enrolled for a full year and said amount shall be prorated for any student enrolled for less than a full year.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end (same in L.D. 444) a new section as follows:

'Sec. 5. Effective date. This Act shall become effective January 1, 1969.'
