HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 317, L.D. 451, Bill, "An Act
Regulating the Daily Limit of Certain Fish Taken from
Inland Waters of the State."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last sentence
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more
than ~~15~~ 12 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass
species during any one day of any open season, from any or all
of the inland waters of Arrostook County except as provided for
by rules and regulations of the department under section 1960.'
