SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 317, L. D. 451, Bill, "An Act Regulating the Daily Limit of Certain Fish Taken from Inland Waters of the State."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first sentence of the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more than 12 8 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass species during any one day of any open season, from any or all of the inland waters of the State except in the Gounty-of

Areesteek Northern Zone for hunting deer and except as provided for by rules and regulations of the department under section 1960.'
