STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Regulating the Daily Limit of Certain Fish Taken from Inland Waters of the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2553, amended. The first paragraph of section 2553 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more than ± 8 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass species during any one day of any open season, from any or all of the inland waters of the State except in the County of Aroostook and except as provided for by rules and regulations of the department under section 1960. No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more than ± 5 10 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass species during any one day of any open season, from any or all of the inland waters of Aroostook County except as provided for by rules and regulations of the department under section 1960.
