AN ACT To Increase Membership of Baxter State Park Authority.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 901, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 901 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

They shall be under the joint supervision and control of, and shall be administered by the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, the Forest Commissioner, the Attorney General and the elected State Representatives from Millinocket and Greenville, under the title of Baxter State Park Authority. The chairmanship of the authority shall rotate every 2 years between the 3 state department heads. On the effective date of this Act, the commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game shall become chairman, followed by the Attorney General and the Forest Commissioner. The authority shall meet at least 3 times each year at the call of the chairman, once in Augusta, once in Millinocket and once in Greenville. Said meetings shall be advertised at least 7 days prior to the meeting, in a newspaper with general state-wide circulation in the area in which the meeting is to be held. All meetings shall be open to the public. Members shall be reimbursed for actual expenses.
