STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Commissioner of Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 101, amended. Section 101 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 507 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 101. Appointment; salary

The board shall appoint a Commissioner of Education, as heretofore appointed and in this Title called the "commissioner", whenever a vacancy occurs and fix his salary not to exceed \$18,000 per year. The commissioner shall be executive officer and ex officio secretary of the board.
