## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Mandatory Competitive Bids on State Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 5, § 1714, sub-§ 3, amended.** The first paragraph of subsection 3 of section 1714 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Place such insurance with companies or agents licensed to do business in the State of Maine to effect the best possible contracts as to services, coverages and costs; such placement <del>customarily</del> shall be made by competitive bidding, except that the board may in exceptional circumstances, if a certificate from the Insurance Commissioner states that the subject matter is not an appropriate one for competitive bidding, place insurance by negotiation.
