### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

### AN ACT Relating to War Orphans

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 20, § 3211, amended. The first sentence of section 3211 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

For the purposes of administering this chapter, an orphan of a veteran shall be defined as a child not under 16 years of age whose father served in the military or naval forces of the United States during World War I, World War II or, the Korean Campaign or the Viet Nam Operation and was killed in action or died from a service-connected disability as a result of such service. For purposes of this chapter the Viet Nam Operation shall be defined as beginning August 5, 1964 and continuing until formal cessation of hostilities.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 and \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969. The breakdown shall be as follows:
