STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Reimbursement for Additional Professional Work by Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 1902, amended. The first sentence of section 1902 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof: Whenever any certified teacher completes, within any 2-year period, 6 credit hours of additional professional work approved by the superintendent, the teacher shall receive an amount of not less than \$100 from the administrative unit. Expenditures for this purpose shall be included as a proper cost in calculating expenditures which may be reimbursed by the State under the foundation program as defined in section 3721, subsection 2.
