## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 103rd LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 213, L. D. 476, Bill, "An Act Relating to School Entrance Age Requirements."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the 3rd and 4th paragraphs (same in L. D. 476) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'In schools which offer a ene-year-ehildheed-education-program prior-to-grade-ene kindergarten program, only those ehildren boys who will be 5 years of age on or before October-15th June 1st of the school year and only those girls who will be 5 years of age on or before September 1st of the school year shall be admitted, except that not more than 5 pilot programs related to school entrance age may be administered locally with approval of the State Board of Education during the 1965-66, 1966-67 school years only. Grade one age limitations shall not apply to children participating in these pilot programs.

In schools which offer a 2-year-ehildhood-education-program prior-to-grade-one kindergarten and prekindergarten program, only those ehildren boys who will be 4 years of age on or before October-15th June 1st of the school year and only those girls who will be 4 years of age on or before September 1st of the school year shall be admitted.'
