HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 213, L.D. 476, Bill, "An Act
Relating to School Entrance Age Requirements."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end a new section as
follows: (same in L.D. 476)

'Sec. 3. R. S., T. 20, §859, amended. Section 859 of
Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended
by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, children
transferring from other states, who have been legally enrolled
in public kindergarten or grade one, may be admitted to that
grade level upon agreement of the superintending school committee
or board of directors and the parents or guardians. Grade one
limitations shall not apply to such transferees.'
