AN ACT Relating to Technical Assistance by Maine State Park and Recreation Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 602, sub-§ 13, additional. Section 602 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new subsection 13, as follows:

13. Technical assistance. To provide information, advice and technical assistance to all persons seeking to establish, improve or expand any commercial campground, bathing beach, marina, picnic or tenting area, and to coordinate the dissemination of such information, advice and assistance with other departments of the State; and to make available to such persons information relating to the standards and requirements of the laws of the State and regulations of the various state agencies with respect to such operations.
