SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 221, L. D. 484, Bill, "An Act to Establish and Appropriate Funds for a Youth Community Acitivity Section in the Department of Mental Health and Corrections."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the underlined words "which are" in the 6th line of the 2nd paragraph of that part designated "§252." of section 1 (5th line of L. D. 484) the underlined words 'desirous of' and by striking out in the next to the last line the underlined words "all-out" (last line of L. D. 484)

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "§253." of section 1 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§253. Funds awarded

The commissioner is authorized to grant funds not exceeding \$350 each to communities and nonprofit organizations who have youth or similar activities which promote the overall objectives of this chapter.'
