AN ACT Establishing the Closing Time for Polls.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 741, sub-§ 2, repealed and replaced. Subsection 2 of section 741 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes as amended by chapter 108 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

2. **Closing time fixed.** The polls must be closed at 8 p.m. on election day, except that towns with 500 or less population may close the polls at 7 p.m.
