SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 349, L.D. 497, Bill, "An Act Removing Tolls from Augusta Memorial Bridge."

Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the period at the end and adding 'and Joshua L. Chamberlain Bridge.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 2. P. & S. L.1951, c. 212, repealed. Chapter 212 of the private and special laws of 1951, which authorizes the construction of a toll bridge across the Penobscot River between the Cities of Bangor and Brewer, is repealed.'
