SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 355, L. D. 502, Bill, "An Act  
Relating to Closed Season on Bear."

Amend said Bill by inserting after the enacting clause the  
following section:

'Sec. 1. R. S., T. 12, §2355-A, amended. Section 2355 A  
of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to  
read as follows:

§2355-A. Closed time on bear

There shall be a closed season on bear from January 1st to  
June 1st in each calendar year, except that this section shall  
not apply to the hunting of bear on an owner's land by the owner  
of such land or his agent.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the  
first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end, before the  
period, the following: ', except that this sentence shall not  
apply to the trapping of bear on an owner's land by the owner of  
such land or his agent'
