AN ACT Relating to Definition of Sporting Camp Under Fish and Game Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2254, amended. The first paragraph of section 2254 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

A sporting camp, under this section, shall include any camp, lodge, or building **or lumber camp**, regularly or temporarily open for hunting and fishing parties as distinguished from private dwellings, and which are situated in any of the unorganized townships in the State.
