COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 360, L.D. 507, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Charges by Camp Owners Under Fish and Game
Laws to Hunters or Fishermen."

Amend said Bill in the 6th line (4th line in L.D. 507)
by inserting after the underlined word "camp" the underlined
words 'in unorganized territory'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end (same in
L.D. 507) the following underlined sentence: 'For the purpose
of this section a single meal shall not be construed to mean
keep, lodge or board.'
