**AN ACT Relating to Charges by Camp Owners Under Fish and Game Laws
to Hunters or Fishermen.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2252-B, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 2252-B, to read as follows:

§ 2252-B. Services rendered hunters or fishermen

It shall be unlawful for the owner or proprietor of any camp maintained partly or wholly in any lumbering operation to take, keep, lodge or board at a fee or for services rendered any hunter or fisherman.
