STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Closing to Fishing that Portion of the Thoroughfare So Called, Between Nesowadnehunk (Sourdnahunk) Lake and Outlet Dam, Piscataquis County.

Fishing in Piscataquis County regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to close to all fishing for the years 1968 and 1969 that portion of the thoroughfare, so called, between Nesowadnehunk (Sourdnahunk) Lake and the dam, northerly from the dam for an approximate distance of 1,000 feet to red posts set on the shore of said thoroughfare of Nesowadnehunk Lake (Sourdnahunk).
