AN ACT Relating to Appeal by Municipalities from Valuations of Board of Equalization.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 292, amended. Section 292 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph, to read as follows:

If any municipality deems itself aggrieved by the assessed valuation of the Board of Equalization, certified and deposited as provided by law, the municipality may appeal therefrom to the Superior Court for the county within which the municipality is located in the same manner as appeals are provided under section 381 for any owner or owners of land in an unorganized township.
