RESOLVE, Authorizing Attorney General to Convey Interest of the State in Certain Islands in Little Sebago Lake to Merton A. Look.

Certain islands conveyed to Merton A. Look. Resolved: That the Attorney General is authorized to convey by quitclaim deed to Merton A. Look, of Westbrook, the interest of the State in 2 small islands situated in Little Sebago Lake in the Town of Gray, Cumberland County, and being known as Treasure Island, and a small island adjecent thereto, which islands lie in whole or in part between the ancient low water mark as established by the common law and the present low water mark of said lake.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

By chapter 46 of the resolves of 1957, the State conveyed its interest to such lands to such persons as had on August 28, 1957 deeds and conveyances of record purporting to convey to them title to such lands. The person who owned such lands on August 28, 1957 is now dead and Mr. Look purchased the land from the heirs. The said chapter 46 limits the identity of the grantee and this resolve is to correct this limitation.
