STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting Aliens Employed in Lumber Operations to Possess Firearms.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2458-A, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 2458-A, to read as follows:

§ 2458-A. Aliens in lumber operations possessing firearms

It shall be unlawful for any alien who is working in this State in a lumber operation and is under bond to have in possession a firearm.
