**AN ACT Relating to Business Days and Hours as to Sale of Liquor on Sunday,  
January 1st.**

---

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 28, § 4, amended.** The 2nd sentence of section 4 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 302 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Liquor may be sold on January 1st of any year from midnight to 2 a.m. ~~unless~~  
~~January 1st falls on Sunday.~~
