STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Business Days and Hours as to Sale of Liquor on Sunday, January 1st.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 4, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 4 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 302 of the public laws of 1965, is amended to read as follows:

Liquor may be sold on January 1st of any year from midnight to 2 a.m. unless January 1st falls on Sunday.
