STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Sunday Sale of Liquor if January 1st Falls on Sunday or Monday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 4, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 4 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by chapter 302 of the public laws of 1065, is amended to read as follows:

Liquor may be sold on January 1st of any year from midnight to 2 a.m. unless January 1st falls on Sunday. If January 1st falls on Monday, licensees shall be permitted to sell or deliver any liquors between 9 p.m., Sunday, December 31st and 2 a.m., January 1st.
