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**AN ACT Increasing the Terms of Trustees for the Maine Maritime Academy.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1941, c. 37, § 1, amended.** The 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 37 of the private and special laws of 1941, as amended by chapter 39 of the private and special laws of 1949, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The affairs of the school shall be controlled by a board of 12 trustees, as heretofore appointed, all residents of the State of Maine, who, together with their successors, shall be appointed by the Governor of the State of Maine, with the advice and consent of the Council. The trustees shall be appointed to serve for terms of 7 years, or until their successors are duly appointed and qualified. Any vacancy on the board shall be filled by appointment by the Governor for the remainder of the unexpired term, but the majority of the board shall carry on business during the existence of any vacancy on the board. Appointments for terms of 7 years shall apply only to those appointments which are made after the effective date of this Act.
