**AN ACT Providing for Paid Holidays for Municipal Employees of the City of
Lewiston.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XVI, § 1-A, repealed and replaced. Section 1-A of Article XVI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 110 of the private and special laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Sec. 1-A. Paid holidays. Municipal employees shall have the following paid holidays: New Year's Day, Washington's Birthday, Patriots Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If and when any one or all of the aforesaid holidays shall fall on a day or days when said municipal employees are off duty as a part of their regular shift, or when holidays fall on a Saturday or Sunday, then those employees shall be paid for said holiday or holidays in addition to their regular time off.
