AN ACT Providing Funds for Roads and Athletic Field at Maine Maritime Academy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Roads and athletic field at Maine Maritime Academy; fund for. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Maritime Academy the sum of \$125,800 for resurfacing roads and walks with hardtop and for an athletic field. Such appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this Act have been accomplished.
