RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Search of Lost Persons in the Woodlands of the State.

Appropriation for search of lost persons. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$35,218 to reimburse the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game for expenses incurred during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1965 and the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 for attempting to find lost persons in the woodlands of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Under the Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 1903, the expenses of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game in attempting to find lost persons in the woodlands of the State is chargeable to the General Fund. The purpose of this resolve is to reimburse the department for expenses incurred during the fiscal years ending June 30, 1965 and June 30, 1966.
