STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Establishing a Commuter College of the University of Maine in Aroostook County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Commuter College in Aroostook County. The trustees of the University of Maine are directed to establish in Aroostook County, at a site to be selected by the trustees, a branch of the University of Maine as a commuter college and there is appropriated the sum of \$1,000,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the University of Maine to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The purpose of this Act is to provide accredited low-cost commuter-type college facilities in Aroostook County. It is basically designed to supplement and not necessarily conflict with the master plan for higher education recommended by the Advisory Commission for the Higher Education Study.
