COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 239, L. D. 564, Resolve,
Authorizing the Disposal of Northern Maine Sanatorium.

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the Title thereof,
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, operation of the Northern Maine Sanatorium was
discontinued in 1961 and no state agency has indicated a need
or use for the real estate or appurtenances; and

Whereas, maintenance of the real estate and appurtenances
on a stand-by basis is costing the State approximately \$31,000
annually; and

Whereas, in order to save this amount of money and to
dispose of the property as advantageously as possible, the
following legislation is vitally necessary to proceed with the
disposal of the property as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end, before the
Statement of Facts, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'
