**RESOLVE, in Favor of Paul V. Douglass of Winslow for Well Damage by
Highway Construction.**

Paul V. Douglass; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,055.90 to be paid to Paul V. Douglass, D.S.C., of Winslow as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to his domestic water supply and furnace caused by the depositing by the State Highway Commission of salt on the Augusta Road, Route 201.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

After more than 20 years of use, Mr. Douglass began to have trouble with his well. The heating element in the furnace plugged tight and on being cleaned out promptly plugged up again. Mr. Douglass had an expert from the Dynatron people in Boston test his water softener and he stated that salt from the road had gotten into the well and there was nothing he could do about it. He advised drilling another well.
