COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 405, L.D. 571, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Trapping Beaver."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the
first line the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof, a
new section, as follows:

'Sec. 2. R.S., T. 12, §2360, amended. The 9th paragraph
of section 2360 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised,
is amended to read as follows:

Any beaver skin or beaver skins that come into this State
in any manner from any other state or country shall have bear the
official stamp, tag or seal of the state or country from which
said skin or skins were taken. Any beaver skin or beaver skins
that come into this State in any manner from any other state,
country or province thereof which does not require an official
stamp, tag or seal of that state, country or province thereof,
shall be tagged in accordance with this section by the person
possessing such skins.'
