COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 413, L.D. 579, Bill, "An Act
Describing the Boundary Line Between the Towns of Paris
and West Paris."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th
and 10th lines from the end (4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th lines from
the end of L.D. 579) the underlined words and punctuation "to the
Buckfield town line; thence continuing in the same southerly
direction along the town line between the Town of Paris and the
Town of Buckfield to the point where the line between lot 18 and
lot 19 in said Town of Paris intersects the town line between the
Towns of Paris and Buckfield, and" and inserting in place thereof
the following: 'to a granite marker defining the southwesterly
corner of the Town of Sumner; thence south 20° 30' east for a
distance of 3,100 feet, more or less, to a marker on the north-
westerly corner of the Town of Buckfield; thence southerly to'
