IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Prohibiting Legislators from Being Liquor Salesmen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 904, additional. Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 904, to read as follows:

§ 904. Legislators not to be salesmen

No member of the Legislature shall be a salesman for a concern selling liquor to the State.
