IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Establishing Clerk of Courts in Somerset County as Full-Time.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 554, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 554 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 330 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by inserting after the 2nd sentence, a new sentence to read as follows:

The office of clerk of courts in Somerset County is designated a full-time county office.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. That part of the 14th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 397 of the public laws of 1965, which relates to salary of clerk of courts of Somerset County, is amended to read as follows:

clerk of courts, \$4,900 \$12,000;
