AN ACT Relating to Buildings for Education Programs for Retarded Children
No Longer Used for the Purpose.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 20, § 3162, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 3162 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

If the buildings for which county funds have been expended under this section shall not be used for the operation of such programs, the amount of funds expended by the county for the buildings shall revert be returned to the county.
