AN ACT Regulating Riding on Motorcycles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 956, additional. Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 956, to read as follows:

§ 956. Riding on motorcycles

A person operating a motorcycle shall ride only upon the permanent and regular seat attached thereto, and such operator shall not carry any other person nor shall any other person ride on a motorcycle, unless such motorcycle is designed to carry more than one person, in which event a passenger may ride upon the permanent and regular seat if designed for 2 persons, or upon another seat firmly attached to the rear or side of the operator, and provided with foot rests and hand grips or in a sidecar attached to the motorcycle.
