STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Operation of Motorcycles While Learning to Drive.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 537, amended. The last paragraph of section 537 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 303 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

No person while operating a motor scooter, motor bicycle or motorcycle under the authority of a learner's permit shall carry any other person thereon, nor shall a person operate a motor scooter, motor bicycle or motorcycle on a learner's permit other than during daylight hours.
