**AN ACT Prohibiting Signing Name of Another Upon Absentee Ballot
Applications.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 1579, sub-§ 7, amended. Subsection 7 of section 1579 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

7. Ballots and checklists. A person who defaces, falsifies or suppresses a ballot or checklist; or who without authority signs the name of another upon an application for an absentee ballot; or who knowingly makes a false checklist; or who destroys a ballot or checklist, except as permitted by section 1578;
