## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Enforcement Duties of Inland Fish and Game Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2001, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2001 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended as follows:

It shall be the duty of the inland fish and game wardens to enforce all laws relating to inland fisheries and game and all rules and regulations pertaining thereto, Title 7, chapter 707 and sections 3601, 3602, Title 17, sections 2794 and 2798, Title 32, chapter 65; all regulations adopted and approved pursuant to of the Federal Migratory Bird Treaty Act, Act of Congress approved July 3, 1918; all rules and regulations promulgated by the State Park and Recreation Commission relating to hunting, fishing and trapping; all rules and regulations promulgated in accordance with Title 38, section 323 and all rules and regulations promulgated by authority of chapter 206; to arrest all violators thereof, and to prosecute all offenses against the same.
