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**AN ACT Relating to Possession of Dogs or Hunting Gear by Persons Employed  
in Forest Operations.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 12, § 2457-A, additional.** Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 2457-A, to read as follows:

**§ 2457-A. Persons employed in forest operations; possession of dogs or hunting gear**

**No alien employed in a forest or similar operation shall be in possession, in the operation area, of dogs or of edible game, or firearms or any other hunting gear.**
