STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Method of Fixing Salary of Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1951, amended. The last paragraph of section 1951 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The Governor, with the advice and consent of the Council, shall fix the salary of the commissioner who shall receive, in addition to his salary, all necessary traveling expenses.
